

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For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

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CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

- C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.
- D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.
- E. 

The Management, at its discretion, may allow riders to compete without riding coats. If a riding coat is not worn, riders must wear a shirt with a collar or choker, neatly tucked into riding breeches. A raincoat may be worn if conditions require. SCRATCH REFUNDS

Scratches before the close of entries all fees will be refunded upon receipt of written instructions to scratch the entry.

Scratches after the close of pre-entry date and before the start of the show, a full refund of all entry fees less stall fees, \$50 office fee, plus a \$50 scratch fee.

Scratches after the start of the show and before any class enter into a full refund of all entry fees less stall fees, \$50 office fee, plus a \$50 scratch fee. 50% of nominating fee

No refund for classes entered and not scratched during the show. Entry fees shall be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by the Official Show Veterinarian (or a medical doctor in the case of an Amateur-Owner or Equitation rider) stating that the horse (rider) is unable to perform in the class(es) entered.

If a Nominated Jumper does not show in any jumper class requiring the nominating fee, a refund of 50% of the nominating fee will be given. A Nominated Jumper may not scratch a class on the same day as that class without an Official Show Veterinarian certificate. If a Nominated Jumper scratches with a vet certificate a \$50 scratch fee and a \$50 office fee will apply.

The office fee is non-refundable under any circumstances after the entries close.

POLING

Poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, on the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a 24 hour period, and will forfeit entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a 24 hour period starting from the time of the incident, and will forfeit all entry fees. Any further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at the show.

PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR

Protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries an SEI tag must be worn by all riders at all times while mounted on a horse or pony. Head gear must be properly fitted with the harness secured at all times. (See Rule GR 801)

MEDICAL WASTE

Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles.

Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management

SHOW MANAGEMENT

The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, make changes or split any class, if entries warrant. The Management rule is that 4 horses is considered a class is filled. The rules of the USEF require it.

The Management also reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show, to move classes to another ring, and to decline any entry and to return money owed before or during the show without being liable for compensation.

SHOW VETERINARIAN

Official Show Veterinarian's phone number will be posted at the Horse Show Office.

DOGS

No Dogs or other pets allowed on the grounds unless they are leashed and under control. Unrestrained pets

will be impounded and released only upon payment of a \$50.00 fine $\,$

DOTTED LINES

A dotted line maybe used in any ring at managments descretion.

SCHOOLING

No schooling will be permitted, at any time, in any of the show rings, except during a scheduled warm-up class.

Use the Designated Schooling Areas Only. Please do not school or lunge on the grass!

FIELDSTONE HORSE SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

ANIMAL WELFARE

We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times while the horse is on the showgrounds we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that GR839 which defines the USEF's policy on abuse and GR803 which pertains to the use of whips, will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of a bamboo off-set, or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. Any handling and veterinary treatment should ensure their health and welfare. High standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times. Adequate provision should be made for ventilation, feeding and watering and maintaining a healthy environment. Any method of riding and training should take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered to be abusive. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators are subject under the above rules to elimination from competition and to protest or charge with resulting formal proceedings which may result in severe fines, suspensions or other penalties.


MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MEASUREMENT AND MEMBERSHIP CARDS

All ponies, junior hunters, and children's hunter ponies must present measurement cards or will be required to be measured. See Rule HU169. Each entry form must give the owners USEF/USHJA membership number, proper mailing address, telephone number and either a Social Security number or employer's Federal Identification Number. A copy of each owner's, trainer's, handler's and rider's USEF and USHJA membership cards must be presented to the Show Secretary before any numbers will be given out. Please send a copy of each with your entries.


MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
